RULES

1. Candidates for this award must be members in good standing of the American Legion Auxiliary, Department of New York. There will be two scholarships awarded: one to a Junior Member in her senior year or a graduate of an accredited high school. The second scholarship will be awarded to a Senior Member who is continuing her education to further her studies or to update her job skills. If there are no senior applications that year, a second junior scholarship will be awarded.
2. There will be no limit to the number of applications any one Unit may submit.
3. Applications for the 1st Lt. Michael L. Lewis, Jr. Memorial Fund Scholarship must be secured from the Department Education Chairman and returned to her NO LATER THAN **MARCH 15, 2012**
4. A copy of the current year membership card must accompany the application.
5. The Unit President must certify each application.

SELECTION PROCEDURES

1. A committee of three impartial judges, selected by the scholarship committee of the 1st Lt. Michael L. Lewis, Jr. Memorial Fund will make the selection.
2. The award will be paid at the Annual Department Convention.
3. The decision of the Selection Committee shall be final.
4. Candidates shall be selected on the following basis:

Character	25%
Americanism	25%
Leadership	25%
Scholarship	25%

All applicants will be notified of the selection results.
