3)Non-Traditional Student \$2000 Member in good standing of The American Legion Family and must have held membership for the two preceding years (2022 and 2023), and be a paid member for the current (2024) membership year, OR
A veteran who served in the United States Armed Forces and was honorably discharged, OR The spouse of an active duty servicemember or a veteran who was honorably discharged. Also, a non-traditional student returning to the classroom after some period in which their formal education was interrupted, OR a non-traditional student beginning their education at a later point in life.
