Undeterred, Joe did a letter writing campaign to garner support from our Legion Family together with our own family, friends, colleagues, and neighbors for this amazing initiative. Joe passed away in 2019, but the passion he put into the Walkathon, and service to our Veterans, lives on. As Joe had done, I reached out, and over the past 3 years, Kings County has donated over \$23,000 to the Walkathon, \$8,620 in 2023 alone.
